1. Out of the reasons given for our church to celebrate Advent together, which is the most helpful or challenging to you?

**Why Do We Celebrate Advent?:**

- To point out how God has carefully planned a way to redeem and save His people
  - To proclaim a counterpoint to the consumeristic and pagan culture around us
  - To remind ourselves that Jesus didn't just come once, He also promised to come again
2. How should we appropriately view Mary? What are some ways that you grew in your appreciation of who she is and what God called her to do?
  3. What is the significance of Jesus receiving “the throne of His father David”? How does Isaiah 9:7 deepen our understanding of His eternal kingdom? How is this “Good News” to Mary and to Luke’s readers?
  4. Why is the virgin birth essential for affirming Jesus’ identity as the sinless Son of God and Son of Man?
  5. How does Gabriel’s final declaration to Mary —“Nothing will be impossible with God”—challenge you to believe and obey the Lord today?
  6. Mary responds to the angel’s announcement with a willing obedience: What does humble submission to God look like in the ordinary parts of your life?
