


March 2, 2025 They Ate Their Fill John 6:1-15

1. Why do you think Jesus tested Philip with His question in verse 5?

Does God still test believers in Christ, and if so, how have you experienced this? (See James 1:2-4, James 1:12-13, and 1 Peter 4:12-13)

2. What moments have you faced in your life where you felt like saying "I have no earthly idea what to do"? How does this passage encourage and challenge you to trust in God's promise of provision? (John 6:7;)

- 3. How do you tend to respond when faced with overwhelming needs—like Philip (focused on the impossibility of the problem), like Andrew (offering small solutions but still doubting), like the little boy (simply offering the little that you have to the Lord), or like the crowd (seeking to use Jesus for personal benefit)?
- 4. What is the point of Jesus providing more than enough food (John 6:12-13)? What was the sign supposed to signify?
- 5. Why did Jesus withdraw after the crowd wanted to make Him king? What does that show about His understanding of His mission? (John 6:15)
