


September 28th, 2025 "My Sheep Hear My Voice" John 10:22-42

1.	How does the cultural backdrop of Hanukkah (temple rededication, true vs. false shepherds) add weight to Jesus' words?
2.	What do Jesus' sheep do (10:27)? How is your life shaped by doing these two actions on a daily and weekly basis?
3.	How has your understanding of salvation been strengthened and encouraged by what Jesus promises in John 10:28-29? How would you use this passage with someone who was struggling with their assurance of salvation?
4.	Why do the people not believe Jesus' works and miracles and what does that say about their hearts?
	If someone asked you today, "Why should I believe in Jesus?" how could His works be part of your answer?
5.	Peter preached in Solomon's Portico 6-8 months after John 10 (see Acts 3) and over 2,000 believed in Jesus that day. How does this contrast with the rejection of Jesus here and what does that teach us about God's sovereign timing?
