



John 12:37-50

1. With Thanksgiving approaching, how can you use conversations around the table to point others to the goodness and grace of God?
2. Discuss how it can be that the crowd still didn't believe in Jesus, even after all of His miracles. How should you respond to someone who wishes to see Jesus before they believe in Him?
3. What happens to people when they refuse to believe in Jesus (see John 12:39-40)? In your own life, who have you been praying for that currently has a hard heart to God? (stop to take time to pray for these people as a small group)
4. What do verses 42–43 reveal about the fear of man? What ways have you struggled with a fear of man when you needed to take a stand for Christ?
5. How does Jesus's mission to save, not judge, shape how we relate to unbelievers?
6. What stands out to you from Jesus' summary of His ministry (vs. 44-50)? Share with the group: Which truth about Jesus ministers to your soul?
