Come and See
John 1:35-51

1. Why do you think Andrew and John responded so quickly to John the Baptist's witness about Jesus? Who are the "trusted voices" in your life that led you to follow Jesus?
2. What does Jesus' invitation to "Come and see" reveal about His approach to making disciples? How can we practically invite others to "come and see" Jesus in our lives today?
3. In what ways have you experienced a new sense of identity or purpose as you've come to know Jesus, like Simon becoming Peter?
4. Why do you think Philip followed Jesus when He said, "Follow me"? What does it mean for you personally to follow Jesus in every aspect of your life?
5. When people express skepticism or doubt, why is it important to invite people to "come and see" Jesus rather than trying to win arguments?
6. How does Jesus' command to "follow me" challenge your sense of independence and control over your life?
7. In looking through all the titles that John records for us in chapter 1 of his gospel account (listed in the front of your bulletin): "The Word," "the light of men," "the only begotten Son from the Father," "Lamb of God," "Rabbi," "Messiah," "Son of God," and "King of Israel"—how do these titles build a fuller picture of who He is?

What do we see about Jesus?

“Follow me” - Jesus commands us with authority
