## *Jesus Prays for His Disciples (pt. 2)*

### John 17:14-19

1. Discuss why truth is so important and foundational in our lives, and how is truth defined in this passage compared to cultural definitions of truth?



2. What is the disciples' relationship to the world supposed to look like? How can we keep from going off into the extremes (isolation from the world or imitation of the world)

*Where do you most feel the tension between being “in the world” but “not of it”?*

3. What does Jesus ask regarding the Evil One, and why is that significant? (and how do passages like Ephesians 6:11, James 4:7, and Romans 16:20 help explain this prayer?)
4. How is Jesus' prayer for His disciples to be “sanctified by the truth” answered?
5. What role does God's truth play in shaping your life? How can you grow in this?
6. What does it mean that Jesus sanctifies or sets Himself apart “for their sake”? (vs. 19) How is He acting both as priest and sacrifice in this moment?
