


Sermon Discussion QUESTIONS

May 25th, 2025 *Members of One Another*Romans 12:3-8

- 1. Take time to read through FBC's Covenant of Fellowship (<u>link here</u>). What aspect of this covenant challenges you? What areas are you encouraged to grow in?
- 2. Why is it important not to think "more highly" of ourselves (v.3), and how can we guard against that? How have you seen pride harm relationships in the church?
- 3. How would you describe the current state of community in your life? What might help you develop deeper relationships within the church?
- 4. How does faithfully living out the "one-another commands" enhance our witness with our neighbors and coworkers in our city? How do these commands combat the lies of the surrounding culture?
- 5. Read through and discuss the three reasons we need to study the "one another" commands:
 - · They guard us from being doctrinally right but spiritually dead
 - · They help us fight against the disembodied existence of our culture
 - · They promote a oneness that is a remarkable witness in our age
