God & Time

2 Peter 3:8-10

1. Which phrase best describes your relationship with time: "time flies," "time crawls," "I'm always rushing," or "I rarely watch the clock"? Why?
2. Which point from Sunday's sermon challenged or encouraged you the most? How did it stretch or grow your view of God?
3. How does whole of Psalm 90 help us understand Peter's statement that "one day is as a thousand years"?
4. What does Peter mean when he says God is "not wishing that any should perish"? (2 Pet. 3:9) How should we understand God's desire for repentance alongside His sovereign election?
5. How does the doctrine of God's timeless eternity affect?:
 - ***Our Prayer Life:*** How should God's ability to see the end from the beginning affect the way we pray? How does remembering God's perspective on time change the way you think about unanswered prayers?
 - ***Our Sin Struggles:*** Is there an area where you've been presuming upon God's patience instead of responding with repentance?
 - ***Our Trials:*** How does God's sovereignty over time strengthen your confidence during seasons of waiting and trial?
 - ***Our Evangelism:*** How should God's patience influence the way we interact with unbelieving family members, friends, or coworkers?

6. Look at 2 Peter 3:11-14 – what was the response that Peter was driving towards when talking about God, time, and judgement?
7. Looking back over the last 168 hours, where do you tend to waste or squander time? What practical changes could help you steward your time more wisely this week?

Consider how you can “number [your] days that we may get a heart of wisdom.” (Psalm 90:12, see also Ephesians 5:15-16)?

TIME WITH GOD CHALLENGE: Before the worship night on July 19th, spend three uninterrupted hours with God, including thirty minutes of prayer devoted only to praise and thanksgiving.
