Humility is honestly assessing ourselves in light of God's holiness and our sinfulness

▶ Boasting is the response of pride to success. Self-pity is the response of pride to suffering. Boasting says "I deserve admiration because I have achieved so much." Self-pity says, "I deserve admiration because I have sacrificed so much." Boasting is the voice of pride in the heart of the strong. Self-pity is the voice of the heart in the weak. Boasting sounds selfsufficient. Self-pity sounds self-sacrificing.

A life that dies to self and surrenders to the providential hand of a faithful and gracious God
