- The earliest N.T. writing (45-50 AD)
- Like Proverbs and wisdom literature is not necessarily a logical flow, but hortatory in style.
- Practical in its application of Christian faith
- Emphasis on the works of faith appears to contradict Paul on the gospel of grace

- James the son of Joseph: (brother of Jesus)
