LIVING WISELY

Wisdom is living life in correspondence to reality and in distinction to alternative realities which are identified as folly. Biblical reality is a worldview that sees both the natural and supernatural world and the relationship between the two in order to understand and then live in the world as it actually is.

LIVING WISELY: WISDOM VALUES LIFE

- Proverbs I I:30; The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life
 - He that wins souls is wise
 - The one who gathers lives is wise
 - But violence takes lives away

LIVING WISELY: WISDOM VALUES LIFE

- Life is not merely being alive physically; To value life is to pursue the good in life, symbolized by the "tree of life."
 - The tree of life represents eternal life
 - The tree of life is that which satisfies the soul eternally: realized in an intimate relationship with God
 - The quality of life produced is then the highest good to be valued; relationships with God's image bearers
 - The commodity of value in the highest good is grace (John I; Prov. II)
